Please find below some **very important** information concerning **LEAVING SCHOOL**, your **GCSE RESULTS, COURSEWORK and GCSE CERTIFICATES**.

LOCKERS, TEXTBOOKS AND SCHOOL EQUIPMENT

Students must clear out their locker by the end of their last exam. Any lockers not emptied by that date will have padlocks and contents removed. Any books or equipment borrowed from, loaned by or issued by The Academy must be returned before the end of June. Failure to do so may result in charges being applied or results being withheld until the matter has been satisfactorily resolved.

RESULTS

Your GCSE results will be available for you to collect between 10.00am and 11.00am on Thursday 24th August 2017 from the Reception Area at the College. Please do not arrive at College before this time.

Results not collected by 11.00am will be posted first class. Please note that if you are unable to collect your results in person, you must provide written permission to Mrs Blacklay authorising a nominated person to collect them on your behalf (e.g. your parents). Results will not be emailed.

RESULTS APPEALS

In some circumstances, you may feel that your result in a subject does not reflect your expected performance/outcome. In these cases results may be appealed. If you do wish to query a result please get a parent/carer to email me at asnape@theburgesshillacademy.org.uk in the first instance detailing the subject and nature of the grounds for appeal. In addition, please copy in the Exams Officer using the email jblacklay@theburgesshillacademy.org.uk in the CC box.

We will be in school on Thursday 31st August to review any queries. Appeals costs do vary across exam boards and subjects and we will advise you of the cost before you have to commit. No appeal will be processed without payment being received first. Please also be aware that marks may be moderated down or up or stay the same.

COURSEWORK/CONTROLLED ASSESSMENTS

If you would like to collect coursework/controlled assessments that you have completed for your GCSE/Cambridge National courses, it will be available for collection after college between 3.05pm and 3.50pm on **Tuesday 9th, Wednesday 10th and Thursday 11th January 2018 ONLY.**

The length of time we have to retain work is a restriction imposed by JCQ and the examination boards; please do not come into college asking for your work before these dates. If there is a problem with these dates, please contact the college to arrange another mutually convenient time.

Any work unclaimed after 1st February may be destroyed.

CERTIFICATES

Once you have received your results you will, no doubt, be looking forward to receiving your certificates. We wish to recognise your achievements and for this reason we like to make the issuing of your certificates a special occasion by organising a Presentation of Certificates Evening. This year it will take place on **THURSDAY 16th NOVEMBER 2017** in the Barnden Hall at 7.00 pm. This is always a popular and enjoyable event; a time for reunion, sharing your new experiences and catching up with all the latest news. A letter of invitation to this event, with a reply slip, will be issued with your results. **It is imperative that you return the reply slip in order to secure a place, as numbers at this event have to be limited due to safety regulations.**

CERTIFICATES WILL NOT BE ISSUED UNTIL THIS EVENT

Please note that if you are unable to collect your certificates on the evening of the presentations, you will be able to obtain these from A-block Reception on any college day before the Friday 8th December 2017. I regret that we will be obliged to charge a search fee of £5 for the issue of certificates after that date.

IMPORTANT: No certificates will be posted to candidates. They **MUST** be collected from College. **Please note that all uncollected certificates will be returned to the examination boards in September 2018.**

GCSE certificates are important documents and should always be kept safely by you as they are the only acceptable proof of your qualifications. If you lose your certificates they are both difficult and expensive to replace.
