**English, Maths and Transitions**

**English**

This term Year 6 will be reading a number of stories which convey a warning message to the reader. They will then use the structure to help them create their own warning story. As part of the process the pupils will develop their ability to create suspense, use a range figurative language to build an image in the readers mind and develop the ability to immediately grab the reader's attention thus making them want to continue reading. The final writing unit will involve the pupils using their persuasive skills to convince an audience to their way of thinking.



**Transitions**

Part of English this term will be supporting the pupils for transition to secondary school. They will be given the opportunity to look at timetables, organisation and the expectations of what is to come. During the term there will be a number of days when the children will be visiting their new schools. The dates being the 5th and 6th of July.

**Maths**

This term's Maths will give the children exciting opportunities to apply all their mathematical learning from this year including multiplication and subtraction to a range of activities, which includes creating their own games and developing problem solving strategies. A lot of the problems will be linked to everyday situations such as the General Election. Furthermore they will be applying their knowledge of shapes to solve logic and visual puzzles as well as finding, describing and predicting patterns.
