Two Fantastic opportunities from the Music Department!

Giving our children the chance to try out different experiences is what all parents want, whether it be visiting new places, trying out new skills or getting involved with new activities. They are all important in building aspirations and helping make new friends. The problem is that some of the things we would dearly love to let them do are very expensive! This is where we in the Music Department can help.

Here are two fantastic musical opportunities for your son/daughter for next term. Next term we are offering two schemes where students can have 10 group lessons on brass instruments (trumpet, baritone horn and trombone) and 10 group lessons on woodwind instruments (flute, clarinet and saxophone). They are given by specialist visiting teachers from West Sussex Music and are COMPLETELY FREE!

The lessons will take place during the school day and instruments will be provided for them to use during the lesson but not to take home. Following these schemes, your son/daughter will then have the opportunity to start proper lessons. The good news continues in that the Music Department will subsidise the lessons so instead of costing £9.00 you will only pay £3.50 per lesson!
