Year 11 Breakfast Club Revision Sessions

As part of the run up to exams and the revision period, we want to do our best to support, guide and motivate our students. As such we are beginning to run our Breakfast Club Revision Sessions commencing on Friday 23rd February and every Friday until Friday 11th May. The sessions will run from 7.30am until 8.20am and as an incentive for students who come in to do this extra work, there will be a selection of bacon rolls and pain au chocolat from which they can choose. These sessions have proved very popular with students in previous years, making a significant positive impact on their revision and helping them to achieve their full potential. It is a great way to boost their performance whilst easing the burden and stress in the run up to the exams.

The sessions will take place in T11, T12 and T13 primarily, though there may be some room changes if a teacher is offering a particular support session that has different needs. Students will sign in and be able to work on their revision, either on computer or using more traditional methods. It is a chance to forge ahead with revision and have experts around to support and help.

There will be a sign up sheet in T block from each Monday to Wednesday for students to confirm they will be attending on the Friday of that same week, so that we are able to provide sufficient food for all of those attending.

I would appreciate if you could discuss this with your son/daughter and encourage them to partake in the Breakfast Club Revision Programme. As a guide each student should be undertaking two to three hours of revision per day at this stage and this can contribute towards that time. If they attend Breakfast Club and period 6 on Fridays then the weekend begins at 4.00pm as they have no other revision to do that day!

May I please ask that you continue to actively engage with your son/daughter and their revision. Discussing their timetable and checking/testing what they say they have revised. A concerted effort and united approach over the coming months should enable all students to maximise their achievements in the final exams.
