

Riding a moped to College

If you are thinking of riding your moped or scooter to College, there are a number of criteria to meet before you can do so:

1. You must have a valid licence.
2. You must have a valid CBT pass certificate.
3. You must have insurance that covers not only social, domestic and pleasure but also commuting/travel to and from a place of work. In the past, this was covered by the social, domestic and pleasure category, but now a number of insurance companies are charging for/adding this in separately. If it is not specified in the policy inclusion/exclusion criteria please can you check with your insurance company and get confirmation sent. Without this you will not be allowed to park your vehicle on College property.
4. You need to bring in the above paperwork to be scrutinised, whereupon a permission slip will be issued which you must keep on you and have able when asked for by a member of staff.

Only once the permission slip has been issued, you may ride your vehicle to College and park it in the main car park. You must be aware that your vehicle is parked there at your own risk and the College does not accept responsibility for any losses/damage whilst your vehicle is on site.

Permission to ride onto College site will be removed in the following circumstances:

- Any instance of dangerous or reckless driving that jeopardises the safety of others in the opinion of staff on duty.
- Any occasion where duty staff instructions or guidance is not followed or adhered to.

Furthermore, in the event of an accident on the College site, it must be reported to the College immediately whereupon staff will decide upon the best course of action, which may well include calling the police or other emergency services for support. In some instances, these services charge when reporting to the scene of a traffic accident.
